

# Autistic people with experience of PIP: help shape a new research study



Researchers at the University of Bristol are planning a study about Personal Independence Payment (PIP) and adult social care.



We want to understand what PIP makes possible in autistic people's everyday lives, including how it may support independence, wellbeing, daily routines, relationships and the need for support.



Before we apply for funding, we would like to speak with autistic people who receive, or have received, PIP. We want your views on what the study should focus on, what methods would work best, and how to make the research accessible and relevant to autistic people. Approximately 5 people are needed.
